To request a Military Academy Nomination from my office, please complete this document and mail it to my Oklahoma City District office (postmarked no later than October 31st) or you may bring it to the Oklahoma City District office during regular working hours on or before the 31st of October. When you mail or bring in your nomination application, all supporting documents (including letters of recommendation, transcripts, copies of test scores, etc.) must be in the single envelope you provide. It is the candidate's responsibility to ensure that the application packet is complete at the time of its submission. Failure to follow the application process could disqualify you from consideration.

We will begin accepting nominations on August 1st.
